### FROM OUR PASTOR DAVE WEBER

Many people go through life afraid to let people see who they really are. At the bottom of this fear is, "If they know the real me, and don't like me, what can I do?" "What people think of me" is a very powerful motivator. It is still shaping us more than we'd like to admit. It shapes our theology, our politics, and even our values. Sometimes the masks we wear in various settings become for us our reality, and we lose the image of the person we really are. God created us in His image and likeness and saw that we are good! We are the apple of God's eye. He chose you before the creation of the universe to be in relationship with Him. You are unique and special to God and God never measures us one against another but for who He created us to be.

Do any of us go through one entire day being utterly true to our genuine selves no matter how many different environments we move through? Do you even know the true you? Is there a true you? Whether it is born of fear or longing or uncertainty or cunning or wickedness, it is so natural for us to shape ourselves according to the moment we scarcely notice how much we do it. Now, toss in the promise of reward — wealth, power, success, the adoration of others—and boy, oh boy, is it hard to be true.

Only when you have taken an honest look inside yourself, and seen what really fuels the things you do, will you appreciate how utterly remarkable it is to be true. And how utterly desirable. We are given the story of Jesus' wilderness trial to help us understand that Jesus has been tried—and proven true. Remember now, Jesus wasn't cheating; it was a genuine test of his character, so profoundly terrible, to be seduced by the evil one himself, that Jesus needed angels to minister to him afterward.

We typically think of integrity as the ability to resist temptation by resolve. And that's a good thing; self-discipline is a good thing. But there is another level of integrity, the kind where you don't even want the seduction that is being presented to you. Goodness runs so deep, so pervasive through your character and your being that you don't even want it. We respect the man who is able to reject sexual temptation. But how much more the man whose soul is such that he does not want any woman but the woman he loves and is married to.

### Party Pear Salad from Sue Porterfield

1 (29 oz.) can pear halves 1/3 c. cinnamon candies

1 (3 oz.) pkg. cream cheese

2 Tbsp. milk

2 Tbsp. slivered almonds

1 tsp. lemon juice 1/3 c. flaked coconut

1 (9 oz.) can crushed pineapple, drained

Drain pears, reserving syrup. Combine syrup and candies over heat until dissolved. Add pears and bring to boil. Remove from heat and chill overnight. Blend cheese, milk and lemon juice. Add coconut, pineapple and almonds. Drain pears and place filling in center of 2 pear halves, spreading to edges. Chill, then serve stuffed pears standing upright on lettuce bed.
